ROAD TRAFFIC

The A21 Trunk Road (Scotney Castle Roundabout – Flimwell Crossroads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *19th May 2014*
Coming into force - - *7th June 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of the A21 and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Scotney Castle Roundabout – Flimwell Crossroads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 7th June 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the A21” means the A21 Trunk Road in the Counties of East Sussex and Kent;

“the length of carriageway” means both carriageways of the trunk road between Scotney Castle roundabout (B2169) and Flimwell crossroads (A268/B2087);

“a side road” means any road leading to or from the length of trunk road between Scotney Castle roundabout (B2169) and Flimwell crossroads (A268/B2087);

“the unnamed road” means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at 925 metres north of Flimwell Crossroad and leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at 1133 metres south of Rosemary Lane which leads to Pillory Corner;

“works” mean pavement investigations and all associated carriageway work; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 9th June 2014 or any subsequent day until 6th December 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a side road, the length of carriageway and the unnamed road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(a) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (d) a vehicle proceeding in the length of carriageway, a side road and the unnamed road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
