TRIAL AND SENTENCE IN A MAGISTRATES' COURT

Evidence by admission

37.6.—(1) This rule applies where—

- (a) a party introduces in evidence a fact admitted by another party; or
- (b) parties jointly admit a fact.
- (2) Unless the court otherwise directs, a written record must be made of the admission.

[Note. See section 10 of the Criminal Justice Act 1967(1). The admissibility of evidence that a party introduces is governed by rules of evidence.]
