**PART 50**

**CIVIL BEHAVIOUR ORDERS AFTER VERDICT OR FINDING**

**Evidence to assist the court: special rules**

- 50.4.**—(1) This rule applies where the court can make on its own initiative—
- (a) a football banning order;
  - (b) a restraining order;
  - (c) an anti-social behaviour order; or
  - (d) a drinking banning order.
- (2) A party who wants the court to take account of evidence not already introduced must—
- (a) serve notice in writing on—
    - (i) the court officer, and
    - (ii) every other party,as soon as practicable (without waiting for the verdict); and
  - (b) in the notice, identify that evidence; and
  - (c) attach any written statement containing such evidence.

*[Note. If a party relies on hearsay evidence, see also rules 50.6, 50.7, and 50.8.]*
