

## SCHEDULE

### Authorised fuels

**57.** Supacite briquettes, manufactured by Maxibrite Limited at Llantrisant, Rhondda Cynon Taf, South Wales, which—

- (a) comprise anthracite fines (as to approximately 84% of the total weight), petroleum coke (as to approximately 12% of the total weight) and starch as binder (as to the remaining weight);
- (b) were manufactured from those constituents by a process involving roll-pressing and heat treatment at approximately 240°C;
- (c) are unmarked ovoid-shaped briquettes;
- (d) have an average weight of 45 grams per briquette; and
- (e) have a sulphur content not exceeding 2% of the total weight.

**Changes to legislation:**
