

“the third length of trunk road”	means the eastbound and westbound carriageway of the A45 from a point 400 metres south of Chowns Mill Roundabout, to a point 400 metres north of that roundabout, including Chowns Mill Roundabout;
“the fourth length of trunk road”	means – a) Chowns Mill Roundabout; and b) the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45 between Skew Bridge Roundabout and Stanwick Roundabout;
“layby”	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 21st September 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- 3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.
- 4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road.
- 5.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the third length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.
- 6.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the fourth length of trunk road.
- 7.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the fourth length of trunk road.
- 8.** Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Chowns Mill Roundabout from the A6 or A5028.
- 9.** The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

10. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- (c) article 6 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the fourth length of trunk road; and
- (d) articles 6, 7 and 8 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
