**The M60 Motorway (Junction 25 Anticlockwise and Clockwise
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *16th September 2014*

Coming into force - - *5th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on three of those slip roads in the Districts of Tameside and Stockport in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 25 Anticlockwise and Clockwise Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th October 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M60 Motorway;

“works” means sign installation and maintenance works on the motorway;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) starting on Monday 6th October 2014 and ending on Friday 31st October 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 25;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 25;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 25.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second and third slip roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or vehicles being used for winter maintenance purposes or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
