**The Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention  
Accommodation) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2014**

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 103(2)(a) and (6) of the Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders Act 2012<sup>(1)</sup>.

**Citation and Commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 1st December 2014.

**Amendment to the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) Regulations 2013**

2. Regulation 3(5) of the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) Regulations 2013 (liability for costs of a child being subject to a remand to youth detention accommodation)<sup>(2)</sup> is amended as follows—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (d)<sup>(3)</sup> after “20th May 2014” insert “(but before 1st December 2014)”;  
and
- (b) after sub-paragraph (d) insert—
  - “(e) on or after 1st December 2014, £529.”.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) Regulations 2013 ([S.I. 2013/507](#)) by inserting a new amount which designated local authorities are liable to pay the Youth Justice Board for England and Wales in respect of each night on which a child is detained on remand in a secure training centre on or after 1st December 2014. The amount is reduced from £533 per night to £529 per night.
