# The Marriage of Same Sex Couples (Conversion of Civil Partnership) Regulations 2014

#### **Armed Forces Conversions**

#### **Conversion procedure**

- **38.** Before the parties to a civil partnership can convert their civil partnership into a marriage under this Part, they must—
  - (a) attend together in person before the authorised person;
  - (b) give the authorised person the details required to complete the conversion declaration;
  - (c) provide a certified copy of the entry in the civil partnership register made on the formation of their civil partnership [Flor, if the conversion is of a convertible Northern Ireland civil partnership, a document issued under section 155(3)(b) of the Civil Partnership Act 2004 relating to the registration of their civil partnership];
  - (d) provide such evidence as may be required by the authorised person to satisfy the authorised person of the details provided in the conversion declaration.
