CONSEQUENTIAL MODIFICATIONS TO SECONDARY LEGISLATION

Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations 1978

3. In regulation 3(2) of the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations 1978⁽¹⁾ (continuation in force of sections 36, 37 and 118(1) of the 1965 Act)—

(a) omit the “and” at the end of sub-paragraph (c); and

(b) after sub-paragraph (d) insert—

“and

(e) to extend section 37 of the 1965 Act to men and their late husbands, and women and their late wives.”.
