TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS, REPEALS, REVOCATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

Review

- **76.**—(1) Before the end of the review period, the Secretary of State must—
 - (a) carry out a review of these Regulations;
 - (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
 - (c) publish the report.
- (2) In carrying out the review, the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonably practicable, have regard to how other member States have implemented Council Directive 1992/104/EEC(1) on the minimum requirements for improving the safety and health protection of workers in surface and underground mineral-extracting industries, which regulations 7, 9 to 17, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25, 26, 28, 29, 32 to 34, 37, 39, 41 to 43, 45 to 50, 53, 55 to 57, 59, 60 and 69 implement.
 - (3) The report must, in particular,—
 - (a) set out the objectives intended to be achieved by the regulatory system established by these Regulations;
 - (b) assess the extent to which those objectives are achieved; and
 - (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved with a system that imposes less regulation.
- (4) In this regulation, "review period" means the period of five years beginning with the commencement date.
