The Payments to Governments and Miscellaneous Provisions Regulations 2014

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Payments to Governments and Miscellaneous Provisions Regulations 2014.
 - (2) These Regulations come into force as follows—
 - (a) regulations 2, 3(1), 4, 5(1) and (3) and 6 come into force on 17thDecember 2014;
 - (b) regulation 5(2) comes into force—
 - (i) for the purposes of sections 73A(5) and 84(4) of the Act, on 12th March 2015; and
 - (ii) for all remaining purposes, on 1st January 2016;
 - (c) regulation 3(2) comes into force on 1st January 2016.
 - (3) In these Regulations, "the Act" means the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000(1).
