**The Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments
(Protection Measures) Regulations 2014**

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“incoming protection measure” means a protection measure that has been ordered in a Member State of the European Union other than ^{F1}... Denmark;

“protection measure” has the meaning given by Article 3 of the Protection Measures Regulation;

“Protection Measures Regulation” means Regulation (EU) No 606/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 June 2013 on mutual recognition of protection measures in civil matters⁽¹⁾.
