ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-On-Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014

Made - - - - 1st December 2014

Coming into force - - 8th December 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road ("the A500") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads, at Stoke-On-Trent in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-On-Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 8th December 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"

means -

- a) the northbound carriageway of the A500 from the junction with the slip road leading to City Road, to the junction with the slip road leading from the A5006 Stoke Road; and
- the southbound carriageway of the A500 from the junction with the slip road leading to the A5006 Stoke Road, to the junction with the slip road leading from City Road;

"a slip road"

means any slip road leading to the trunk road;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 15th December 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - c) being used in connection with the said works.
