**The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2014**

**PART 2**

**SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS**

**Rates of age addition**

**11.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 10(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) Regulations 1994<sup>(1)</sup> (increase in rate of incapacity benefit where beneficiary is under prescribed age on the qualifying date)—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£20.70” substitute “£21.25”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “£10.35” substitute “£10.65”.

(2) In the case of a claimant entitled to long-term incapacity benefit the sums specified in regulation 10(2)(a) and (b) shall be increased to “£11.00” and “£6.15” respectively.
