

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force on 21st March 2014 section 140(4) to (6) of the Financial Services (Banking Reform) Act 2013 (c. 33) (“the Act”). This is the third commencement order to be made under the Act.

Section 140(4) to (6) amends the Legal Services Act 2007 (c. 29) to allow the recovery of expenditure incurred by the Office for Legal Complaints in dealing with claims management complaints.

This Order will have no effect on the costs of business and the voluntary sector independent of the provisions this Order brings into force. For that reason, no impact assessment has been produced for this instrument.
