The Police Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 2014

Made - - - - *15th January 2014*
Laid before Parliament *23rd January 2014*
Coming into force - - *13th March 2014*

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 to 7 of the Police Pensions Act 1976⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with section 1(1) of that Act, the Treasury⁽²⁾ have consented to the making of these Regulations and the Secretary of State has consulted with the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom⁽³⁾.
