The Coal Industry Act 1994 (Commencement  
No. 8 and Transitional Provision) Order 2014

**Transitional provision**

**3.** Any redundant mineworkers and concessionary coal payments scheme made under, or continued in force by virtue of, section 7 of the Coal Industry Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> continues to have effect for the purpose of the recovery of any overpayments, notwithstanding the repeal of that provision.
