

**TRANSPOSITION NOTE**

**Articles 4 and 24 of Directive 2012/27/EU<sup>1</sup> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on energy efficiency**

Introductory Note

This Transposition Note refers only to Articles 4 and 24 of Directive 2012/27/EU. Other articles will be transposed by separate legislation, where necessary.

The Energy Efficiency (Building Renovation and Reporting) Regulations 2014 transpose Articles 4 and 24 in the United Kingdom.

Article	Objective	Transposition
4	Sets out the requirement to establish a long-term strategy for mobilising investment in the renovation of the national building stock. Sub paragraphs (a) to (e) detail the compulsory contents of the strategy. This strategy must be published by 30 April 2014 as part of the National Energy Efficiency Action Plan and updated every three years thereafter.	Regulation 3 imposes a statutory duty on the Secretary of State, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers, Welsh Ministers and Northern Ireland Departments, to fulfil this requirement.
24(1)	Contains the requirement to report on the progress achieved towards national energy efficiency targets, in accordance with Part 1 of Annex XIV, by 30 April each year.	Regulation 4(a) imposes a statutory duty on the Secretary of State, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers, Welsh Ministers and Northern Ireland Departments, to fulfil this requirement.
24(2)	Contains the requirement to submit a National Energy Efficiency Action Plan (NEEAP) by 30 April 2014 and every three years thereafter. The NEEAP must include information the information specified in Part 2 of Annex XIV and detail measures which demonstrate compliance with the Directive.	Regulation 5 imposes a statutory duty on the Secretary of State, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers, Welsh Ministers and Northern Ireland Departments, to fulfil this requirement.
24(3) – (5)	Impose obligations on the Commission.	These provisions do not require transposition as they impose obligations on the Commission.
24(6)	Contains the requirement to submit statistics on cogeneration and district heating and cooling by 30 April each year.	Regulation 4(b) imposes a statutory duty on the Secretary of State, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers, Welsh Ministers and Northern Ireland Departments, to fulfil this requirement.
24(7) – (11)	Impose obligations on the Commission.	These provisions do not require transposition as they impose obligations on the Commission.
