- (3) In regulation 3(2) for the definition of "local authority" substitute—""local authority" means—
- (a) in relation to a local authority in England—
 - (i) a county council, a district council, a London borough council, a parish council, the Council of the Isles of Scilly;
 - (ii) the Common Council of the City of London in its capacity as local authority or police authority; or
 - (iii) the Greater London Authority or a functional body within the meaning of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 M1;
- (b) in relation to a local authority in Wales, a county council, a county borough council or a community council;
- (c) in relation to Scotland, a local authority within the meaning of section 235(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 M2 and also includes a joint board or joint committee within the meaning of section 235(1) of that Act;
- (d) in relation to a local authority in Northern Ireland, a district council within the meaning of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 M3.".
- (4) In regulations 5 and 21 for "the Public Contracts Regulations 2006", in each place it occurs, substitute "Part 2 of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015".
