# The Willington C Gas Pipeline (Correction) Order 2015

Made - - - - 18th August 2015

Coming into force - - 19th August 2015

The Willington C Gas Pipeline Order 2014 (the "Order")(**a**), which granted development consent within the meaning of the Planning Act 2008 (the "Act")(**b**), contained correctable errors within the meaning of the Act.

In accordance with paragraph 1(5)(a) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Secretary of State received, before the end of the relevant period referred to in paragraph 1(6)(a) of that Schedule, a written request from RWE Generation UK plc to correct errors and omissions in the Order. In accordance with paragraph 1(7) of that Schedule, the Secretary of State informed Derbyshire County Council, East Staffordshire Borough Council, South Derbyshire District Council and Staffordshire County Council that the request had been received.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers in paragraph 1(4) and (8) of that Schedule, makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Willington C Gas Pipeline (Correction) Order 2015 and comes into force on 19th August 2015.

#### Corrections

- **2.** The Willington C Gas Pipeline Order 2014 is corrected as set out in the table in the Schedule, where—
  - (a) column 1 sets out where the correction is to be made; and
