# Variation and termination of contracts

# Termination by [F1NHS England] for the provision of untrue etc. information

- **66.**—(1) [FINHS England] may give notice in writing to the contractor terminating the contract with immediate effect or from such date as may be specified by [FINHS England] in the notice where sub-paragraph (2) applies.
- (2) This sub-paragraph applies if, after the contract was entered into, it comes to [FINHS England's] attention that written information—
  - (a) provided to [FINHS England] by the contractor before the contract was entered into; or
  - (b) included in a notice given to [FINHS England] by the contractor under paragraph 50(1) (a) or (b) or 51(1),

relating to the conditions set out in regulations 5 and 6 (and compliance with those conditions) was, when given, untrue or inaccurate in a material respect.
