**The Financial Services and Markets Act 2000
(Regulated Activities) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2015**

Made - - - - 4th November 2015

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

In the opinion of the Treasury, one of the effects of this Order is that an activity which is not a regulated activity, within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000(1), will become a regulated activity.

A draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament in accordance with paragraph 26(2) of Schedule 2 to the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000(2).

The Treasury make this Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 22(1) and (5) of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000.
