Overseas visitors exempt from charges

NATO forces

- **21.**—(1) No charge may be made or recovered in respect of any relevant services provided to an overseas visitor who is a person to whom Article IX(5) of the Agreement regarding the Status of Forces of Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty (agreed in London on 19th June 1951) ^{M1} applies.
- (2) This regulation applies where the services in question cannot readily be provided by the medical services of the armed forces of—
 - (a) the overseas visitor's own country; or
 - (b) the United Kingdom.
