The Animal Feed (Hygiene, Sampling etc. and Enforcement) (England) Regulations 2015

PART 5

Enforcement powers and related provisions

Penalties for offences

34.—(1) A person guilty of an offence under regulation 5, as read with Table 1 of Schedule 2, or regulation 24(3), 28(5), 29(5) or (6) or 31(2) is liable —

- (a) on summary conviction to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months or to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, or both;
- (b) on conviction on indictment to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 2 years or to a fine, or both.

(2) A person guilty of an offence under regulation 5, as read with Table 2 of Schedule 2, or regulation 20 or 32(1) or (2) is liable on summary conviction to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months or to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or both.

(3) A person guilty of an offence under regulation 32(3) is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale.
