**The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2015**

**PART 2**

**SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS**

**Rates of transitional invalidity allowance**

**12.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 18(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) (Transitional) Regulations 1995<sup>(1)</sup> (rate of long-term incapacity benefit in transitional cases)—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£21.25” substitute “£21.50”;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “£13.70” substitute “£13.90”; and
- (c) in sub-paragraph (c) for “£6.85” substitute “£6.95”.

(2) In the case of a claimant entitled to long-term incapacity benefit the sums specified in regulation 18(2)(a), (b) and (c) shall be increased to “£11.15”, “£6.20” and “£6.20” respectively.
