**CHILD TRUST FUNDS**

**The Child Trust Funds (Amendment) Regulations 2015**

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12(2) and 28(1) of the Child Trust Funds Act 2004<sup>(1)</sup>, make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Child Trust Funds (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 6th April 2015.

**Amendment of the Child Trust Fund Regulations 2004**

2. The Child Trust Funds Regulations 2004<sup>(2)</sup> are amended as follows.
3. In regulation 9(2) and (3)(annual limit on subscriptions), for “£4,000”, substitute “£4,080”.
