**ECCLESIASTICAL LAW, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Grants to the Churches Conservation Trust Order 2015**

*Made* - - - - *24th March 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *1st April 2015*

The Secretary of State, with the approval of the Treasury, makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Redundant Churches and other Religious Buildings Act 1969<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup>:

In accordance with section 1(4) of that Act, a draft of this instrument was laid before and approved by a resolution of the House of Commons.

The [Pastoral Measure 1968 \(1968 No.1\)](#) established the Redundant Churches Fund and section 13(1) of the [Pastoral \(Amendment\) Measure 1994 \(1994 No.1\)](#) changed the name of the Redundant Churches Fund to the Churches Conservation Trust. Section 13(2) of the Pastoral (Amendment) Measure 1994 provided that reference to the Redundant Churches Fund in section 1(1) of the Redundant Churches and other Religious Buildings Act 1969 should be construed as a reference to the Churches Conservation Trust. The Pastoral (Amendment) Measure 1994 was repealed by the [Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011 \(2011 No.3\)](#) and the operation of the Churches Conservation Trust is now governed by section 57 of the 2011 Measure.
