# The International Interests in Aircraft Equipment (Cape Town Convention) Regulations 2015

Made---23rd March 2015Laid before Parliament26th March 2015

Coming into force in accordance with Regulation 2

The Secretary of State is designated M1 for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 M2 in relation to property interests in moveable objects.

The Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment and its Protocol on matters specific to Aircraft Equipment signed on 16th November 2001 are together to be regarded as an EU Treaty as defined in section 1(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, by virtue of the European Union (Definition of Treaties) (Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment and Protocol thereto on matters specific to Aircraft Equipment) Order 2014 M3.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, makes the following Regulations:
