

## SCHEDULE 3

### APPLICATION OF EXISTING PROVISIONS OF REGULATIONS

#### PART 1

#### THE 2001 REGULATIONS (ENGLAND AND WALES) AND THE 2001 REGULATIONS (SCOTLAND)

##### **Interpretation of Part 5**

**20.** Regulation 64 of the relevant regulations (interpretation of Part 5)(1) has effect for the purposes of the referendum as if—

- (a) the following were substituted for the definition of “agent”—  
““agent”, except in regulation 69, means a referendum agent or an agent appointed under regulation 69;”, and
- (b) in the definition of “valid postal voting statement”, for “returning officer” there were substituted “counting officer”.
