The Antarctic (Recognised Assistance Dog) Regulations 2016

Prescribed trainers of recognised assistance dogs

3. A “recognised assistance dog” in section 8(5) of the Antarctic Act 1994 is a dog which has been trained to assist a disabled person—

- (a) in relation to dogs trained in the United Kingdom—
 - (i) by the Guide Dogs for the Blind Association, a charity registered in England and Wales (No. 209617) and in Scotland (No. SC038979); or
 - (ii) by an organisation which is a registered member of Assistance Dogs (UK), a charity registered in England and Wales (No. 1119538);
- (b) in relation to dogs trained outside the United Kingdom—
 - (i) by a person or organisation that is affiliated to the International Guide Dog Federation, a charity registered in England and Wales (No. 1062441); or
 - (ii) by a person or organisation accredited by Assistance Dogs International, a company registered in the State of Oregon, United States of America (No. 117502-88).
