Under article 41 of the Charter of the United Nations, the Security Council of the United Nations has, by resolution adopted on 25th May 2016, terminated the measures adopted in respect of Liberia:

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the United Nations Act $1946(\mathbf{a})$, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order as follows:

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Liberia (United Nations Sanctions) (Revocation) Order 2016 and comes into force on 10th August 2016.

(2) This Order extends to the United Kingdom.

Revocation

2. The Liberia (United Nations Sanctions) Order 2004(**b**) is revoked.
