The Compensation Orders (Disqualified Directors) Proceedings (England and Wales) Rules 2016

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Compensation Orders (Disqualified Directors) Proceedings (England and Wales) Rules 2016.
 - (2) These Rules come into force on 1st October 2016.
 - (3) In these Rules—
 - "the Act" means the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 and a reference to a numbered section is to that section of that Act;
 - "CPR" followed by a Part or rule by number means that Part or rule with that number in the Civil Procedure Rules 1998(1);
 - "practice direction" means a direction as to the practice and procedure of any court within the scope of the Civil Procedure Rules 1998;
 - "registrar" has the same meaning as in rule 13.2(3A) of the Insolvency Rules 1986(2); and "relevant party" means—
 - (a) the defendant (in the case of an application under section 15A(1)(3)); or
 - (b) the Secretary of State (in the case of an application under section 15C(1)(4)).
