The Regulation of Social Housing (Influence of Local Authorities) (England) Regulations 2017

PART 1

Introductory

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“appointed day” is the day after the end of the period of six months beginning with the day on which the regulations are made;

“board” means—

- (a) in the case of a charity which is not a registered company, a board of trustees,
- (b) in the case of a company, a board of directors, and
- (c) in the case of a registered society, the society’s committee⁽¹⁾;

“constitution” relates to terms set out in any documentation providing for the constitution of a private registered provider;

“local authority officer” means an officer⁽²⁾ appointed to the board of a private registered provider by a local authority.

(1) See section 275 of the Housing and Regeneration Act 2008 (c. 17) for the meaning of “registered company” and “registered society”.

(2) “Officer” in relation to a private registered provider, has the meaning given by section 270 of the Housing and Regeneration Act 2008 (c. 17), which includes a trustee in the case of a charity which is not formed as a company, a director in the case of a company, and in the case of a registered society a person co-opted to serve on the society’s committee; see section 93(5) of the Housing and Planning Act 2016.
