**The Control of Mercury (Enforcement) Regulations 2017**

**PART 8**

**Amendments and revocation**

**Amendment to section 41 of the Environment Act 1995**

**48.** In section 41(1) of the EA 1995<sup>(1)</sup> (which confers power to make schemes imposing charges), after paragraph (h) insert—

“(k) as a means of recovering costs incurred by it in performing functions conferred by Regulation EU 2017/852 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2017 on mercury, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1102/2008<sup>(2)</sup>, the Agency, the Natural Resources Body for Wales or SEPA may require the payment to it of such charges as may from time to time be prescribed;”.
