SCHEDULE 2

Conformity assessment module A

Internal production control

1. Internal production control is the conformity assessment procedure whereby the manufacturer fulfils the obligations laid down in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 and ensures and declares on his sole responsibility that the radio equipment concerned satisfies the essential requirements.

Technical documentation

2. The manufacturer must establish the technical documentation in accordance with regulation 45 (technical documentation).

Manufacturing

3. The manufacturer must take all measures necessary so that the manufacturing process and its monitoring ensure compliance of the manufactured radio equipment with the technical documentation referred to in paragraph 2 and with the essential requirements.

[F1UK] marking and F2... declaration of conformity E+W+S

- **4.**—(1) The manufacturer must affix the [F³UK] marking in accordance with regulations 39 (prohibition on improper use of [F³UK] marking) and 44 ([F³UK] marking) to each item of radio equipment that satisfies the applicable requirements of these Regulations.
- (2) The manufacturer must draw up a written ^{F4}... declaration of conformity for each radio equipment type and keep it together with the technical documentation at the disposal of the national authorities for 10 years after the radio equipment has been placed on the market. The ^{F4}... declaration of conformity must identify the radio equipment for which it has been drawn up.
- (3) A copy of the F5... declaration of conformity must be made available to the relevant authorities upon request.
