Universal Credit: transitional and savings provisions

## Claimants who are providing evidence of having limited capability for work before 3rd April 2017

- 11. The third circumstance is where—
  - (a) before 3rd April 2017—
    - (i) it falls to be determined whether the claimant has limited capability for work; and
    - (ii) the claimant has provided evidence of having limited capability for work in accordance with the Social Security (Medical Evidence) Regulations 1976(1); and
  - (b) on or after 3rd April 2017 a determination that the claimant has limited capability for work is made on the basis of an assessment under Part 5 of the Universal Credit Regulations 2013, on revision under section 9 of the Social Security Act 1998(2) or on appeal.
