The Occupational Pension Schemes and Social Security (Schemes that were Contracted-out and Graduated Retirement Benefit) (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2017

Made - - - - 9th March 2017

Laid before Parliament 13th March 2017

Coming into force - - 6th April 2017

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 62(1)(a) and (c) and 175(3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(1), sections 16(3) and (4), 17(6), 20(1) and (3), 55(2C), 56(2), 57(1) and (2), 181(1)(2), 182(2) and (3) and 183(1) of the Pension Schemes Act 1993(3) and sections 51(2C), 52(2), 53(1) and (2), 176(1)(4), 177(2) to (4) and 178(1) of the Pension Schemes (Northern Ireland) Act 1993(5).

In accordance with section 185(1) of the Pension Schemes Act 1993(6), and for the purposes of regulations 2 and 4, the Secretary of State has consulted such persons as the Secretary of State considers appropriate.
