Her Majesty, in exercise of the power conferred upon Her by section 37(2) of the British Nationality Act 1981(a), by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, orders as follows.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the British Nationality (Maldives) Order 2017 and comes into force on 12th May 2017.

Amendment of Schedule 3 to the British Nationality Act 1981

2. In Schedule 3 to the British Nationality Act 1981(**b**) (countries whose citizens are Commonwealth citizens), omit "Maldives".
