# The Combined Authorities (Mayors) (Filling of Vacancies) Order 2017

### Filling of vacancies in the office of elected mayor

- **3.**—(1) This Order applies where a vacancy in the office of elected mayor of a combined authority [FI or a combined county authority] occurs before expiry of the mayor's term of office due to—
  - (a) the death or resignation of the mayor;
  - (b) the mayor's election being declared void; or
  - (c) the office being declared vacant.
- (2) Where the vacancy occurs at least six months before the expiry of the mayor's term of office, it shall be filled at a by-election to be held on the day determined in accordance with article 6.
- (3) Otherwise, it shall be filled at the election to be held on the day determined by reference to  $\Gamma^{F2}$ 
  - (a) in the case of a mayor of a combined authority, paragraph 2 of Schedule 5B to the 2009 Act;
  - (b) in the case of a mayor of a combined county authority, paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the 2023 Act.]
