**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Forth Road Bridge,
Edinburgh) (Amendment) Regulations 2017**

Made - - - - *4th September 2017*

Coming into force - - *5th September 2017*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the Forth Road Bridges, Edinburgh, by reason of events associated with the intended opening of the new river crossing which will be attended by a number of important persons and a large number of members of the public.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Forth Road Bridge, Edinburgh) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into force on 5th September 2017.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Forth Road Bridge, Edinburgh) Regulations 2017(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(2)—

- (a) at the end of sub-paragraph (b) omit “and”,
- (b) in sub-paragraph (c) for “.” substitute “, and”, and
- (c) after sub-paragraph (c) insert—

“(d) between 0700 hours and 1930 hours on 5th September 2017.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Forth Road Bridge, Edinburgh) Regulations 2017 (S.I. 2017/894). The amendment adds restrictions of flying on 5th September 2017.
