FEES UNDER THE MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT 1995

PART 11

Copies of, and Extracts from, Documents

1. In this part, "copy" means a certified copy of—

- (a) a declaration or other document, a copy of which is made evidence by virtue of the Act, or
- (b) an extract from a document declared by the Act to be admissible in evidence.
- 2. The fee for a copy of a document is £15 for each hour or part of an hour required for copying.

3. Where a person requests and receives premium service, a fee of $\pounds 50$ is payable in addition to the aggregate of the fees for copying done on the same occasion.
