## The Rail Passengers' Rights and Obligations (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018

### PART 3

#### Amendment of retained direct EU legislation

**8.** In Article 10—

“**2.** The NTSN relating to the subsystem ‘telematics applications for passenger services’ (the TAP NTSN) applies for the purposes of this Regulation.”;]

[<sup>F2</sup>(aa) omit paragraph 3;]

[<sup>F3</sup>(b) in paragraph 4, for “the TSI” substitute “the TAP NTSN”.]

(c) in paragraph 5, for “Directive [95/46/EC](#)” substitute “ Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive [95/46/EC](#) (General Data Protection Regulation) and the Data Protection Act 2018 <sup>M1</sup> ”.
