The Secretary of State and the Welsh Ministers make these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2 and 7(9) of and Schedule 1 to the Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999(1) (“the 1999 Act”).

In accordance with section 2(4) of the 1999 Act, the Secretary of State and the Welsh Ministers have consulted—

- (a) the Environment Agency;
- (b) the Natural Resources Body for Wales;
- (c) such bodies and persons as appear to them to be representative of the interests of local government, industry, agriculture and small business as they considered appropriate; and
- (d) such other bodies or persons as they considered appropriate.

A further amendment was made to section 2 which is not relevant to this instrument. Schedule 1 was amended by [S.I. 2011/1043](#). Further amendments to Schedule 1 were made which are not relevant to this instrument.
