The Animal Gatherings (Fees) (England) Order 2018

Fees payable

3.—(1) The fees payable to the Secretary of State for the issue, amendment or renewal of a licence under the 2010 Order are to be determined in accordance with Table 1 of the Schedule.

(2) The fees payable to the Secretary of State for the issue and renewal of a licence to organise shows or exhibitions under the 2010 Order are to be determined in accordance with Table 2 of the Schedule.

(3) Additional fees related to travel time and extra veterinary visits payable to the Secretary of State are to be determined in accordance with Table 3 of the Schedule.

(4) A person is exempt from a licence fee where the animal gathering on premises, or on the part of [^{F1}premises] to which the licence relates, involves—

- (a) only shows or exhibitions that are open to the public for not more than one day at a time, in circumstances where no public sale or auction of animals takes place;
- (b) a gathering solely for the purpose of an inspection to confirm that animals possess specific breed characteristics.
