SECTION 2

Export declarations made orally

Export declarations made orally by an individual

- 17.—[F1(1)] [F2Subject to paragraph (2),] an individual may make an export declaration orally in respect of any of the following goods—
 - (a) non-commercial goods;
 - (b) personal gifts on export;
 - (c) goods where—
 - (i) the value of the goods does not exceed [F3the amount specified in a notice published by HMRC under regulation 17A(3)], F4...
 - (ii) the weight of the goods does not exceed 1000kg [F5, and
 - (iii) the goods are not subject to excise duty.]
 - (d) goods which-
 - (i) are a means of transport subject to registration in the United Kingdom, and
 - (ii) [F6meet] any further conditions provided in a notice which may be given by HMRC;
 - (e) any spare parts, accessories and equipment connected to that means of transport;
 - (f) fodder and feeding stuffs accompanying animals for the purpose of feeding them during their exportation;
 - [F7(g) packaging which is not intended for sale and is either—
 - (i) exported filled and intended for import (whether filled or unfilled); or
 - (ii) exported unfilled and intended for import filled.]
- $[^{F8}(1A)]$ Subject to paragraph (2), F9 ... an individual may make an export declaration orally in respect of goods which are listed in Part G of the Oral or By conduct list.]
 - [F10(2) [F11Paragraphs (1) and (1A) do] not apply—
 - (a) where the goods are exported at a location which is specified in a notice published by HMRC; or

(b) to the making of oral declarations of a type specified in a notice published by HMRC.]
