The Magistrates' Courts (Amendment) Rules 2019

Substitution of rule 95

5. For rule 95 (warrant to be signed) substitute—

“Form of warrants issued by magistrates' courts

95.—(1) A warrant of arrest must identify—

- (a) each person to whom it is directed;
- (b) the person against whom it was issued;
- (c) the reason for its issue;
- (d) the ground in relation to which it was issued;
- (e) the court that issued it; and
- (f) the court office for the court that issued it.

(2) Except where any enactment provides otherwise, a warrant issued by a magistrates' court need not bear the name of the justice or other person issuing it, provided that the designated officer has recorded the name of that justice or other person.”.
