
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Articles 2, 3 and 4(3) of this Order provide that the Lebanon and Syria (United Nations Measures) (Overseas Territories) Order 2006 ([S.I. 2006/311](#)), the Lebanon (United Nations Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2007 ([S.I. 2007/283](#)) and Part 1 of the Libya (Restrictive Measures) (Overseas Territories) Order 2011 ([S.I. 2011/1080](#)) will no longer extend to Bermuda, given that they now have the force of law in Bermuda by virtue of the International Sanctions Regulations 2013 (BR 14/2013).

Article 5 of this Order amends the Sanctions (Overseas Territories) (Amendment of Information Provisions) Order 2018 ([S.I. 2018/1076](#)) to remove a defectively drafted provision in that Order, which cannot be effected. Article 4(2) of this Order amends the Libya (Restrictive Measures) (Overseas Territories) Order 2011 ([S.I. 2011/1080](#)) in lieu of that defective provision.
