The Broadcasting (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

In accordance with paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 7 to the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 <sup>M3</sup>, a draft of this instrument has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.
