CHAPTER 3

Financial penalties and public censure: procedure

Warning notice

11.—(1) If the FCA proposes to—

- (a) impose a penalty on a [^{F1}person] under regulation 7, or
- (b) publish a statement in respect of a $[^{F1}$ person] under regulation 10,

it must give the [F1person] a warning notice.

(2) A warning notice about a proposal to impose a penalty must state the amount of the penalty.

(3) A warning notice about a proposal to publish a statement must set out the terms of the statement.
