### Part 2

The Family Procedure Rules 2010: amendment and transitional and saving provision

#### Transitional and saving provision – Part 31

**26.**—(1) Where in relation to any proceedings under Part 31 the relevant saving provision applies, Part 31 continues to apply on and after [<sup>F1</sup>IP completion day] for the purposes of those proceedings as if the amendments made to that Part by these Regulations had not been made.

(2) In this regulation, “the relevant saving provision” means, as applicable—

- (a) regulation 8 of the Jurisdiction and Judgments (Family) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019; or
- (b) regulation 7 of the Civil Partnership and Marriage (Same Sex Couples) (Jurisdiction and Judgments) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 <sup>M1</sup>.
